"A Divine Looking Glass"

Congratulations to Olivia Jones, Sherrie Brown, and Heidi Smith in formally joining the church! We are blessed to have them as members of our church family. Each has participated and attended bringing their spiritual gifts and talents to embolden the congregation's ministry. This is a special time for all of us to pause and deeply reflect on our own spiritual pilgrimage and image as disciples of Jesus Christ.

I have discovered looking into a mirror at any point in time we are being shaped by God. Aging is simply God's sacred chisel carving our bodies, minds, hearts, and souls to reveal God's ultimate divine image of love in Jesus Christ our Lord and Savior. God has a way of chiseling our outer and inner lives to create a deeper understanding of who God is—who we are—and to whom we belong. Our human image becomes the reflection of Jesus Christ.

I would like to share a simple spiritual awareness exercise which deepens our concept of what God's "ultimate" love is in our call to be disciples of Jesus Christ, and what it means to be a member of a church. In the Apostle Paul's First Letter to the Corinthians, he devotes a whole chapter (I Cor. 13:1-13) to the concept of what God's unconditional "love" means. Love means Jesus Christ. Jesus Christ is love. I invite you to pick up your individual Bibles and substitute the word "Christ" for every mention made of "love" in this chapter, and you will begin to see through a mirror darkly and dimly for which you were made. "What is here called love," writes Dietrich Bonhoeffer is his book, Ethics, "is not this general principle but the utterly unique event of the laying down of the life of Jesus Christ for us..." It is Jesus'

death and resurrection by taking up the cross. (Green, Long, Powery, Rigby, Connections, Year C, Volume 1, p. 218, Westminster and John Know Press, 2018)

NEWS FROM THE CLERK'S DESK

- Annual Statistics are due to Presbytery by February 15, 2025.
- Next Presbytery Meeting is via Zoom in March 2025. Mileage rate is \$.70 in 2025.
- Kitchen cart update: 2nd replacement cart arrived 12/24/2024, and it was in bad shape and was photographed and refused. We accepted a credit of \$442.13 (includes shipping) and are looking for a different stainless cart.
- Floyd is going to look at the water fountain upstairs and see if he can fix it.
- Painting is happening in Fellowship Hall, about half of it has been painted.
- Spaghetti dinner is coming up on February 20, 2025. There were about 11-12 people who said they would help. Prices are as follows: \$15 for takeout, \$16 all you can eat dine in and \$5 for kids 10 and under . Spaghetti will have homemade meatballs.
- Finance lets us know Dawn was able to move \$5,000 into the savings at the end of December, \$4,566 over from contributions and an additional \$93 to make it even, plus loan amount. Kevin Garvey, Pastor's coach via Zoom, asks us to ask the following: How are we relevant as a church? Also, he says don't wait until there is a problem to ask the congregation for help.
- Emergency Planning Committee let us know the new security cameras are in. They were on sale so 2 sets were purchased, total \$603.00. This includes 8 cameras. They will be installed as soon as it is warm enough.
- Member Care will host Bingo on February 2nd at BR Fields. Money from Annual Congregational luncheon
 will go to Taymouth Township Fire Dept for putting in the fire and CO2 alarms and for their assistance during
 Rob's Medical emergency. There is a new door sign for February/March- "Don't let the world change your
 smile. Let your smile change the world."




